Committee Reports:

- Banquet: Trolly Station, Middleton, Idaho. December 13th, 2025. Boise Bubbly & Tap
- Year-End Awards: N/A
- Double Point Show: Show was well attended, over 800 entries. Thank you, exhibitors! Thank you to
 our amazing show manager, Connie Keyes! Connie kept the show flowing nicely even with additional
 obstacles that were happening behind the scenes. We appreciate you!!! Thank you, Andrew Vincent, for
 the new ranch gate!! The show staff and volunteers did a great job, and we are very lucky to have a great
 crew! Last to thank, but certainly not least, thank you Idaho Paint Horse Club for hosting the APHA
 classes and sponsoring the APHA highpoint/reserve awards.

Attendees expressed the following:

- Reserve awards not being the same for each division. Exhibitors were very thankful but confused as to why some divisions had different awards. This also created some confusion when it came time to disbursing awards.
- Trail. With the current schedule, it is very hard for trainers to ride all the horses needed before clients compete in their class. Discussed different options of trail warmup to best suit the needs of all exhibitors.
- Pleasure classes. Exhibitors would like to lineup in the middle of the arena and hear their class
 placings prior to exiting. The next class can be loaded in and if needed, an exhibitor can proceed
 to the rail early if they're in the next class.
- Pattern classes. Making sure all cones, walkers, poles, etc. are set correctly before the first horse enters the pattern. On the front end, of hiring judges ISHSA will encourage the same cone set-up for all division of patterns. (Judge will have a final say on pattern choice, although ISHSA will encourage.)
- Any and all changes made to patterns need to be announced property to exhibitors. Discussed multiple ways to do this the most efficiently, i.e. announce over loudspeaker, gate person informing the exhibitor, etc.
- Facility. Additional poles are needed for trail, Tish will reach out to the IHP on this. Discussed their announcement system and possible options to mediate this.
- Drivers would appreciate it if we could stagger the driving classes. I.e. small, medium, big in sizes for each driving order. This will be changed for fall double point.
- Show statements that have not yet been received from the show secretary.





Jamece made a motion to purchase an easel, two ropes for trail, new radios (12 minimum) and caution tape. Seconded by Tammi – all in favor.

Jamece made a motion for Kate Hudson to be a highly qualified judge. Seconded by Tammi – all in favor.

Fall Double Point. Connie will be managing another show and unavailable for us at the fall show. Wade Kirksey will be our Show Manager – Thank you Wade! Mike & Charlene Carter are the AQHA judges and Kate Hudson and John Lindley will be our local judges. Thank you, judges!

Spring 2026. IHP asked if we would be interested in switching dates with the Horse Expo. Due to the early date (weather/travel concerns) and bulls coming in during that time for the PBR, we will decline.

- <u>Youth Committee</u>: Horse Expo added interested parties to emailing list and how to improve next year. Fun classes at spring went ok, great take aways of how judges can judge the fun shows. Submitted new fun shows for the fall double point.
- <u>Website:</u> Up to date. The 5/10 showbill was just approved and now online. Spring double point scoresheets are online. Please reach out to Tish if you see an update that needs to be made.
 - EPRB/LOC (Felicia): Rule proposals are due by August 1st.
 - Gaited Halter: besides a few judges, we need to make sure judges know the rules of gaited halter.
 - 3rd gate to 2nd gate is not allowed. Gaited and Driving Gait Calls (ISHSA to possibly create a small cheat sheet for judges)
 - Championship Halter Setup. "It is <u>suggested</u> the First-Place horse from each breed class be lined up side-by-side, with the Second-Place horse (by breed) directly behind them, allowing adequate room for each breed to properly show according to their breed standards. In the event there is more than one judge, the horses shall be lined up for Judge A and judged, then Judge B, etc."
 - Rules Chairman will coordinate printing and mailing of the 2025 ISHSA Rulebooks to all judges on the ISHSA judges list.
- <u>Scholarship Fund</u>: Permanent number list is up to date; scholarship applications are due by 6/30. Reminder this is for all ages!
- Points (Danette): Working on updating the Spring Double Point points.

<u>Old business:</u> Reminder: If board members are in a paid position, a contract MUST be submitted to the Executive Committee prior to payment.

<u>New business</u>: Megyn is working diligently on the Spring P&L. There are a lot of unanswered questions from the show secretary reports. We will discuss how to proceed with members of the Executive Committee and Rules Committee.
