General Membership Meeting 2-6-2025 Home of Tish Schuster. The meeting called to order by President Patricia Schuster

Attendance: Tish, Anne, John, Bev Google meet: Alyane Blicke, Amy Ouellette, Jamie Denning, Lina Mims, Matt Livengood, Tammi, Felicia, Jamece, Megyn, Shelby, Jamie Wills.

Minutes: Jamece/Tammi moved the minutes approved.

Treasurers Report: General: \$1,496.41

Show: \$25,909.85

Scholarship: \$3,573.65

Awards: \$2,863.36 Report was approved.

Double Point Show: Spring dates are April 11 -13. All judges have been hired. Stalls open 3-5 @ 9:00AM

The show bill has been approved. The Horse Protection Act was discussed. ISHSA has shared the April show bill & will comply with other requirements. A budget was set for awards for the double point shows. Felicia/Jamece moved to limit hi point awards to \$75 & reserve hi point award to \$50. Motion passed. TVPHC will be sponsoring 10 of the reserve awards like they did at the fall show.

Youth group

Megyn brought up the youth club that has been formed. The group has some exciting new ideas, one of those being the lead line a friend class. They asked for a donation of \$250 to rent a booth at the horse expo. Jamece /Bev moved ISHSA to pay for the booth. Motion passed. The youth had ideas to share about awards & those ideas will be shared at the Sunday awards meeting. Please see their flyer for more information.

Awards & Banquet: Megyn has made arrangements with the Trolley House for the 2025 awards banquet.

EPRB/LOC: John brought copies of the changes for the purposed 2025 rule book. Some changes were results of our 2024 ballot. John updated patterns to several divisions. Since ISHSA defers to Pinto & AQHA he updated some scoring rubrics. The rulebook will be online, go to www.ishsa.info to find the rulebook. Those wanting rulebooks will need to pay for them.

Scholarship Fund: \$3,573.65 applications must be in before June 30th. This scholarship is available to all ages, vocational, academic etc.

Points/ website: Tish has talked to Danette about being our 2025 points person. She will be offered the total amount of \$800.

Old business: The audit was done 1-9-2025. The books were in excellent shape. Thank You Megyn.

New business: Anne has emailed all 2024 clubs with a reminder to get their 2025 show approval forms in before 2-28. Judge's list is being finalized.

Alyane & Matt presented some ideas about the new ranch horse club their group has formed. They have 3 show dates & a tentative showbill. They expressed concern about some ISHSA requirements. They will meet & come back next month. ISHSA is happy to help a new club start & are willing to help.
